#### Students of RJSPM Pharmacy excel in SPPU Examination

Students of RJSPM, College of Pharmacy recorded 100% pass percentage in semester examination held in April/May 2021 for B. Pharmacy. Savitribai Phule Pune University declared results of this exam on 1st October 2021. These results were declared online on university website. Overall pass percent of all classes of B Pharmacy are 100%. Total 276 students appeared the examination. 269 students passed in all subjects and 7 students with ATKT. 52 students from first, second and third year scored above 9.10 SGPA. #### Learning, Online or Offline?

The pandemic (covid-19) shocked the entire education system in the world. The pandemic forced schools and colleges to shut down during lockdown period. This leads to the transition of students and teachers to online teaching-learning methods. The pandemic posed several challenges in public and private schools/colleges, which included an expected rise in dropouts, learning losses, and an increase in digital divide. COVID-19 also acted as a catalyst for digital adoption in education. Now schools and colleges are reopening again and students are back to colleges after 15 months of home base learning.

So the question is which system of teaching-learning is suitable? Online or Offline? Students of RJSPM College of Pharmacy have conducted a survey to find answer. In this, they asked following questions to the students.

Which mode is most suitable according to you? From which mode you gain more knowledge?

How much time do you spend each day on an average, on online education? How effective has online education been for you?

Do you enjoy learning online?

Questions were sent through Google forms and total 131 responses were collected from the B Pharmacy students.

Method of survey: Google forms Total no. of responses: 131

Conclusion: According to the survey conducted it is found that almost all students prefer offline mode of education. Students enjoy learning online but they were facing some problems in online education. Offline mode of education is found to be more effective than online mode.







The above pie chart shows the result of a survey in which students were asked about their preferred mode of education, i.e. online or offline. We can see that about 53.7% of students prefer offline study and 47.3% students want online study and also most of the students says that they gain more knowledge from the offline studies rather than online studies. From the pie chart it is cleared that only few students do a regular study for more than 10hr in online mode of education, where 54.2% students do study for 5-6 hrs and 12.2% students for 7-10 hr and 32.1% students for 1-3 hr per day.

30.5% of students say that online study is very effective, where 36.6% students say online study is slightly effective, and 24.4% of students say that online study is moderately effective and 8.4% students this that online study is not at all effective. 45% students enjoy online learning where 25.2% students says that they enjoy online learning but they want some changes in it, where 16.8% students says that online learning is quiet challenging and they face some challenges where only 13% students says that they do not enjoy online learning at all.

The survey was conducted on preferred mode of education and we observed that most of the students prefer offline study rather than online study and are gaining more knowledge from the offline studies. Offline mode of education is effective than online mode. Students from the editorial board of the JIJAU SPECTRUM conducted this survey.

#### Students participated in Pulse Polio Immunization Programme

The Pulse Polio Initiative was started with an aim of achieving hundred percent coverage under Oral Polio Vaccine. It aimed to immunize children through improved social mobilization, plan mop-up operations in areas where poliovirus has almost disappeared and maintain a high level of morale among the public. National Immunization Day (NID) commonly known as Pulse Polio Immunization programme was launched in India in 1995, and is conducted twice in the early part of each year. In these campaigns, children in the age group of 0-5 years are administered polio drops.

RJSPM's College of Pharmacy, NSS students Rutika Suryawanshi, Priyanka Bhor, Srushti Choudhary, Nandini Borate and Aishwarya Ghare took part in the pulse Polio program carried out by government of India on 31 Jan-5 Feb 2020 at government hospital of Moshi. The students worked under the guidance of Sister Anita Gavali and Bhosale sir. Mr.G.R. Sakhare, NSS coordinator, managed all the activities for this programme.

It was a great experience for us, and we learned many things during this programme, said NSS students.

#### Lecture No 4 in Alumni interaction series "Opportunities in pharmacovigilance"




#### Plastic Free Week 18 October 2021 to 24 October 2021




#### Activities conducted under faculty exchange programmes






