- (d) GATI will provide all necessary training material as applicable, which will be mentioned in the training and assessment proposals submitted with RJSPM's College of Pharmacy, Dudulgaon, Pune. from time to time.
- (e) Batch size, payment terms, award of certification and all other relevant details will be as per the training proposals of GATI submitted with RJSPM's College of Pharmacy, Dudulgaon, Pune. from time to time.
- (f) Course dates and timings will be decided on the mutual convenience of both the parties.
- (g) Expert lectures / Workshops / Events: If RJSPM's College of Pharmacy, Dudulgaon, Pune. wishes to organize lecture series / national events, GATI will assist in providing speakers.
- (h) Industrial Visits: GATI will assist RJSPM's College of Pharmacy, Dudulgaon, Pune. in arranging industrial visits of its final year students.



(i) Validity: This MoU is valid for a term of three year(s) from the date of signing, unless terminated earlier or extended by mutual agreement of both the parties at latest thirty days prior to the expiry.


### Summary of faculty development program







#### **Summary:**




