Preface: On the basis of the approval given by Pharmacy Council of India, New Delhi, from the academic year 2023-24, for granting Government approval on permanently un-aided basis to the new institutes of undergraduate pharmacy courses in the state, as well as new courses in existing institutes and University departments and increasing the admission capacity of the ongoing courses, changing the name of the institute etc., the Director, Technical Education has submitted a proposal to the Government *vide* above referenced letters. The said matter was under consideration of the Government.

GOVERNMENT DECISION: Pursuant to the approval given by the Pharmacy Council of India, New Delhi and as proposed by the Director, Technical Education, from the academic year 2023-2024 the institutions mentioned in Annexure A to D as shown in the table below are granted unaided principled government approval on permanently un-aided basis, subject to prevailing terms and conditions.

1. Terms and Conditions:-

- 1) The said approval shall remain on permanently Non-Grant basis.
- 2) The administrative, educational and financial responsibility of the pharmacy courses to be started in the university departments mentioned in the above Annexure C shall remain with the concerned university.
- 3) In the present case the concerned organization shall be bound to fulfil the conditions prescribed by the Pharmacy Council of India, New Delhi as well as prescribed by the Government Order dated May 21, 1983.
- 4) The intake capacity of the institute for the said course shall be as mentioned in the attached Annexures A to D.
- 5) The institution has to sign an affidavit that all the terms and conditions prescribed by the Government as well as prescribed by the Pharmacy Council of India, New Delhi, are acceptable. Also related to documents and formalities will be satisfactorily completed with the approval of Director, Technical Education, and State of Maharashtra.
- 6) The concerned institution should submit a fixed deposit in joint account with the Director, Technical Education and fulfil other legal formalities.
- 7) Admission to the said degree, diploma and post graduate courses will be done as per the admission rules/procedures approved by the government for the said courses.
- 8) Action will be taken against the concerned institutions as per Maharashtra Educational Institutions (Prohibition of Capitation Fees) Act, 1987 if they charge more than the tuition fees prescribed by the Fee Regulatory Authority.
- 9) The institute should appoint full time teaching staff and other technical staff as per the government rules to run the course. Salaries and allowances to the employees shall be paid as per rules. Also, strict action will be taken against the institution if there are any complaints to the government regarding the salary and allowances of the teaching staff and other employees, as well as from the students.
- 10) Books, periodicals required by the library in the institute must be purchased as per the standards of All India Technical Education Council. Also, in order for students to make full use of the library, it is necessary to provide reading/study room to the students in the library. Also students are required to be provided all educational facilities (Eg. laboratories, library, classrooms etc.) as per All India Technical Education Council standards.
- 11) Regarding ragging the directives of the Hon. Supreme Court and the Maharashtra Prohibition of Ragging Act, 1999 shall be strictly implemented.

2. Apart from this, other terms and conditions laid down by the Director, Technical Education, Maharashtra State, Mumbai, Director, Maharashtra State Board of Technical Education, Mumbai and the concerned University shall remain applicable.

3. The Directors should collect from the institutes which have not paid the processing fee to the Director, Technical Education, State of Maharashtra and the Director, Maharashtra State Board of Technical Education, Mumbai, before giving final approval and for inclusion of the course in the centralized admission process. The Director Technical Education, Mumbai and Director Maharashtra State Board of Technical Education, Mumbai should issue necessary orders within next 10 days.

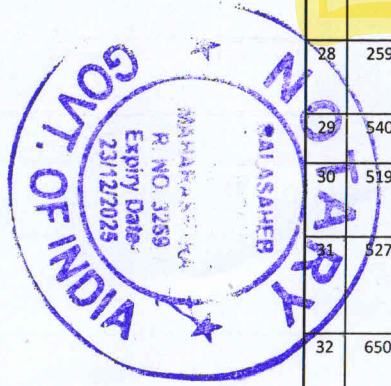
