IN GPAT EXAM THE STUDENTS ACHIEVED EXCELLENT SUCCESS

GRADUATE PHARMACY APTITUDE TEST (GPAT) is a national level entrance examination for entry into M. Pharm programmes. Till 2018, it was conducted by All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) every year as per the directions of Ministry of Education (MoE), Government of India. NTA is conducting this Test since 2019. This Test facilitates institutions to select suitable Pharmacy Graduates for admission into the Masters (M.Pharm) Program. The GPAT is a three hours Computer Based Online Test. A few scholarships and other financial assistance in the field of Pharmacy are also given on the basis of GPAT Scores. On 27-02-2021 GPAT exam was conducted. A total number of 47942 candidates were registered for this examination. 45504 candidates appeared for the examination. The Examination was conducted in 121 Cities in 271 Centres.

From RJSPM COP, 44 students were appeared for GPAT examination 2021. Six students qualified the exam with higher ranks. The list of GPAT qualified students with their All India Rank (AIR) are as follows,

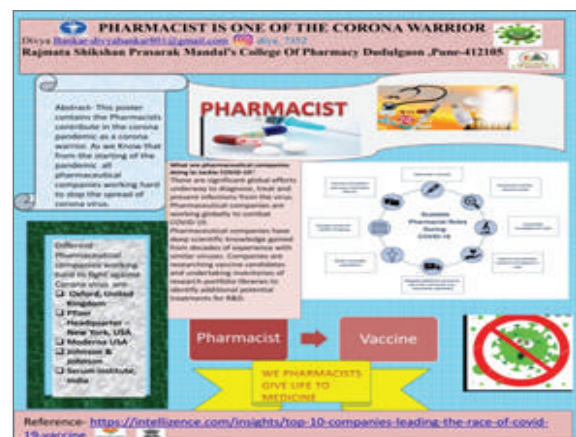

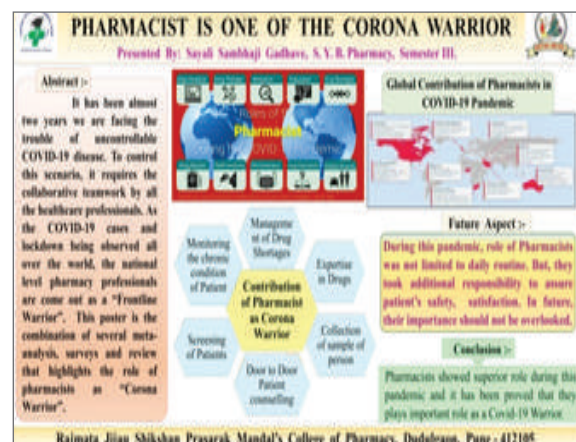

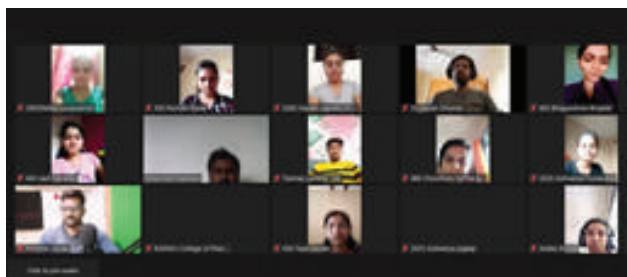

Mr. Rakesh Kumar : Life underwriting

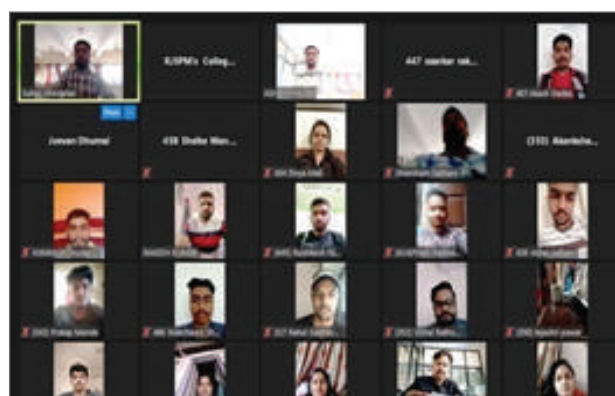
Mr. Akshay Dattatray Holkar : Unexplored Opportunities for Pharma Students in Analytical Method Development

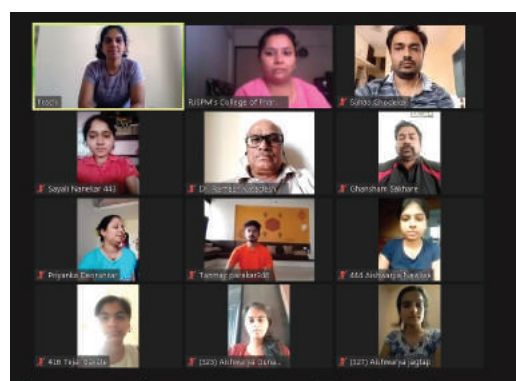

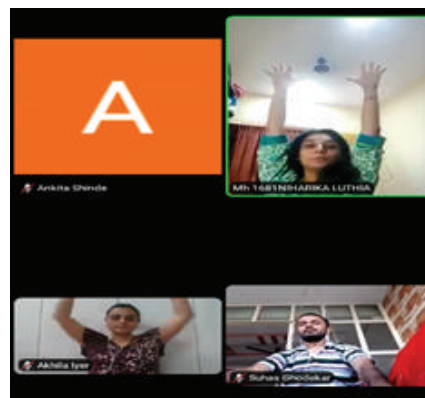
